Finish the challenge and get your own medal and certificate!







Library Services

The Library Services have updated certain fees and charges...

- There are no changes to overdue adult books –
 remains at 35p per day.
- 2. A decrease in overdue charges for children's books (6p down to 5p per day).
- 3. No increase in reservation charges (remains at £1.30).
- 4. DVDs, music CDs, and audiobooks will be charged at a flat rate of £2 per week.
- 5. Printing/copying will increase to 35p for A4 (mono/colour) and 70p for A3 (mono/colour).
